WINERY TOUR/HISTORIC LOS GATOS

MONDAY, 7 MAY 2012, 10:30 A.M. – 4:00 P.M. MEET IN THE LOBBY OF THE FAIRMONT SAN JOSE HOTEL AT 10:15 A.M.

Enjoy a visit to the century-old Testarossa Winery, where OSA guests will tour the winemaking facilities, learn about wine production, and be treated to a private tasting. Located in the historic Novitiate Winery built in 1888 by Jesuits from the college at Mission Santa Clara, the winery produced altar wines and sweet, fortified wines for nearly 100 years. Now operated by the Jensen family, Testarossa is the fourth-oldest continuously operating winery in California. After the winery tour, explore the many boutiques, shops and restaurants in the picturesque town of Los Gatos before returning to San Jose. The tour, tasting and transportation via private bus are free to OSA members, families and friends. Bus space is limited, so pre-registration is encouraged. Be OSA's guest at The Tech Museum, known for its interactive hands-on exhibits that appeal to visitors of all ages. The event will begin with the IMAX Theater film presentation, "Roving Mars." After the film, see the full-scale model of the Mars Science Laboratory Mission's "Curiosity" Rover, on display through 15 July 2012. Launched into space in November 2011, the "Curiosity" rover's mission is to land on Mars this August to search for past or present conditions favorable for life, and conditions capable of preserving a record of life. The rover is the size of an SUV, weighs 1 ton and is filled with features including a geology lab, a rock-vaporizing laser and multiple cameras.
